## WARM-UP

- What do you think is meant by "correctly handling the word of truth" in verse 15?
- Have you ever experienced someone using a text from the bible in a way it was not meant to be used? Describe that experience.
- Why do you think that person used the bible in the way that they did?
- How can you be sure that THEY indeed misused the bible and that YOUR understanding of that passage is more accurate?
