# THE LIFE CHALLENGE

## CONNECT

What do you love about Easter and Holy week? Share something that best represents this season (a story, a song or a verse, etc.)

#### IDENTITY

1. Read the passage in Mark, plus Zechariah 9:9. What image and characteristic do you see in the passage? Why is this important?

2. Compare the image of Jesus on a donkey (coming in peace) with Jesus on a horse in (Rev.19: 11-16). Why is it important to understand both Jesus on a donkey and Jesus on a horse imagery?

3. In the rest of Mark 11 (verses 12-33) the story covers three days of Jesus in Jerusalem. Pastor Garth talked about how Mark was telling a story of Jesus as King, Priests and Prophet (as it relates to Deut 17:14-18:22. It's a much bigger picture of Jesus' roles and who he says he is. How does this help you view Jesus?

#### THE EXAMEN

1. What's a thought you'd like to explore more about Jesus as king, priest, and prophet? How do you relate to Jesus in all three of these roles?

2. Are you convinced Jesus comes to you in peace? What do you need to turn over to him to see in a bigger way?

## PRACTICE

Explore one area of your life (your job, your family role, your leadership, etc.) and define what it means to reflect Jesus in that role. Are you playing the role of a king, priest and prophet, as one of Jesus's disciples?

#### PRAY TOGETHER

Share with each other an area you want to press into more and then pray for each other to see Jesus in bigger ways.
