WARM - UP

DISCUSSION

Did/do you find it hard to love your physical brothers and sisters? How did your relationships change as you aged? In terms of loving each other in the church family does it help to think of church members as actual brothers and sisters?

How does the introduction of agape love change how we should relate to each other? (vs. 22).

DISCUSSION

What is the source or foundation that enables us to love deeply from the heart?

Is there a vice in Peter's list in 2:1 that is a particular trap for you? What are the tools available to help us overcome these vices?

Read Christ's command in John 13:34 & 35. Why is our love for one another such a powerful witness?

APPLICATION

What are some of the tangible ways that we can demonstrate love for one another in the church family? Your neighbourhood? Your family?

Is there a particular act of love that the Spirit is nudging you to perform in the coming week?
