**A - Adoration** - take time for expressions of praise to God for his character and love.

**C - Confession** - allow for a time of silent reflection; invite prayers for corporate or individual confession.

**T - Thanksgiving** - invite expressions of thanks - for God's good gifts; what can we be thankful for in the life of our church; in our families; in our country.

**S - Supplication** - pray for Ukraine/Russia and world leaders; pray for our Church Council, staff, programs and leadership needs; pray for each other.
